Course Description	The study of finance is important to students for both professional and personal reasons. The business students of today will need to be able to understand and use finance principles because most companies need to make financial decisions in many areas of management. Also, at a personal level, students will be making financial decisions throughout their everyday lives. This course is an introduction to the area of finance, emphasizing the core stuff in corporate financial decision making. There will be many cases in which students should use quantitative approach, but intuition is much more emphasized than numerical skills.
Course Objectives	When having finished the course, students should have a basic but good understanding of the following topics: agency problem, cash flows, financial statements, time value of money, annuities, valuation of stocks and bonds, capital budgeting, risk and return, and cost of capital. More advanced topics, such as derivatives, investment analysis with real option approach, hedging FX exposures, insurance and pension, will be covered in the subsequent courses (investment, financial derivatives, and risk and insurance).
